

Eternal Truth Cannot Change!



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Knowing Scripture is true—that says Malachi 3:6 “*I am the LORD, I change not;*” therefore, if *God* cannot change, then His eternal *Truth* cannot change. Numbers 23:19 “*God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do it? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?*”

All gifts and blessings come from God James 1:17 “*With whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.*” God’s Truth continues on earth and on into eternity, so it is our responsibility to retain that Truth in our heart and to live it every day of our life.

God wants everyone 1 Timothy 2:4-6 “*To be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. 5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; 6 Who gave himself a ransom for all.*” To value this atonement that He made is to *live* the Truth He gave.

To give everyone the opportunity to be saved, God had His unchanging Truth written in Scripture, so anyone in the world could *read* it; *know* it; *believe* it; and choose to *live* it! Anyone of any nation who is willing to *read* and *listen* and *learn*, can know God’s eternal Truth.

Romans 16:25 “*Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery [God’s eternal Truth], which*

was kept secret since the world began, 26 But now is made manifest, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the obedience of faith.”

There are millions of religious organizations, giving millions of religious messages in churches, printed in books, heard on radio, or published online, but most fall short of the unchanging eternal Truth of God. Many millions of people are deceived by Satan to accept a teaching that does not include the full counsel of God on vital issues of faith and trust on God.

Any religious message that does not give New Testament financial teaching on how to *use* money scripturally and to *not* store it away for the future; or does not teach divine healing by a believing faith on the Atonement Blood of Christ without using drugs, medicine, or hospital treatment, is omitting vital principles of trust on God that cannot be omitted.

Churches today do *not* teach on trusting God to avenge wrongs without a lawyer; nor do they teach how we can have daily needs without going into debt, without depending on human plans, and without having laid-up cash somewhere. They do *not* teach about claiming divine protection without the use of firearms, anti-burglar systems, or insurance policies; and they do *not* teach that *how* we meet difficulties in *this temporary life*, reveals our faith in God for the *next eternal life*.

A religious message *must* be *inspired* by the Holy Spirit, and based on Scripture, because the Bible is where God explains His divine plan for provisions, health, healing, and replacing the *sin* nature with His *divine* nature—which is the result from allowing Him to *teach* us what we *need* to know—the true standard of *living* by New Testament teaching. If a minister is not giving that Truth, then they are *not* giving God’s unchanging Truth Malachi 3:6.

Most church ministers follow the world’s ways for protection; for money; for healing; and concerning injustices experienced in their own personal lives. So, if they do not live a life of trust on God themselves, they would not be able to explain a life of trust on God to their listeners.

Many profess to have faith in God; they praise the Lord and *say* they believe; but Matthew 7:21 “*Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.*” The will of the Father is to faithfully trust Him in this life.

The Holy Spirit enables a person to understand and live the full Truth of God. John 14:17 “*Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.*”

God’s Truth is learned by first deciding to believe God. 2 Corinthians 4:3-4 “*If, however, the meaning of our Good News has been veiled, the veil has been on the hearts of those who are on the way to perdition, in whom the god of this present age has blinded their unbelieving minds so as to shut out the sunshine of the Good News of the glory of the Christ, who is the image of God.*”

Divine principles of trust that God inspired to be written and which He will reveal to anyone willing to believe, cannot be changed. No matter *who* is speaking, or *how* it is worded, the message has to be according to Bible teaching and example for it to be God’s eternal and unchanging Truth—a Truth that Jesus is John 14:6 “*The way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.*” If anyone is not teaching about trusting in faith on the divine power of God, then they are not giving the unchanging Truth Jesus gave.

Living the same Truth Bible Christians did and being prepared to meet Jesus by the cleansing

power of the Holy Spirit, is not just *saying* we believe but it is *living* like a true believer—as anyone *would* live who believed in the power of the Blood of Christ. The unchanging Truth of the Bible can be explained with different words, but it must *be* God’s Truth, and we have to *live* up to it. John 14:15 “*If ye love me, keep my commandments.*”

When we decide to *live* God’s Truth, spiritual *growth* and scriptural *decisions* will be made through the power of the Holy Spirit concerning every situation. We *first* have to decide to *obey* the Word and *follow* Christ’s commands—Luke 9:62 “*No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.*”

There is to be *no thought* of ever going back to the ways of *no faith* in God like the world. Hebrews 6:4 “*For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Spirit, And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come, If they shall fall away, to renew them again to repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame.*”

Many ministries quote Scripture but follow the ways of the world, rather than trusting the living God of the Bible. Since the *Pastors* do not live by faith themselves, then they are not teaching *others* to trust God in faith—for health, healing, finances, protection, daily needs, avenging wrongs, and all other life issues. Jesus conquered Satan at the Cross—one time for all time—so there is no excuse for not trusting God.

The average religious message heard over the radio or read online, does not teach full obedience to the Word of God, nor do they teach that a true *believer* will follow the *instructions* in Jesus’ Sermon on the Mount Matthew 5, 6, & 7. Most

ministers do *not* trust God in faith for personal finances, so they do *not* teach others to do it either. Galatians 6:7 “*Be not deceived; God is not mocked.*”

They do *not trust* God for protection under the Blood of Christ, and they *reject* God’s divine healing plan of faith in the Atonement Blood of Christ. To *not* trust God for money, protection, healing, justice, or any other life issue, is blatant *unbelief* on God. Scripture says that unbelievers do *not* receive the Holy Spirit, so they are *not* inspired and would *not* teach God’s Truth.

Most religious organizations own property in real estate on which their church and home are built—but Jesus taught us *not* to do that. Most churches place money in a savings’ account on earth—in direct opposition to what Jesus taught—putting our money in heaven, by giving money to the poor Matthew 6:19. Church officials buy insurance policies to protect their financial assets—so they purchase and sign a policy, rather than praying and believing God will protect them by faith.

Most ministers seek hospital care at the first sign of health problems, and they sue each other in court for any injustice against them—rather than obeying God’s Word and placing the matter in His hands for justice. Romans 12:19 “*Never avenge yourselves. Leave that to God*” Deuteronomy 32:35. Owning real estate, laying up treasure on earth, buying insurance policies, hiring a lawyer, and trusting in the medical world, is *not* the teaching of God’s Truth of the Bible and will *not* take anyone to Heaven!

Every part of our life must be given to God to control—*every* part! Our attitudes, our responses, and our decisions must be according to the *Word* of God. We *must* be, and we *can* be scriptural in these things, because the Holy Spirit is given to *anyone* who is *willing* to believe and *willing* to accept God’s Truth as their standard of living.

When we *have* the Holy Spirit in our heart, we *can* respond to things in our life according to the Word He inspired. The Holy Spirit within is all the spiritual light anyone needs to live a righteous life of faith in Christ, and to be prepared for His kingdom. Acts 4:12 “*Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.*”

Teaching people to trust God for everything in this life—including spiritual growth by faith in Christ, is *important* and *very* necessary. God is waiting to teach us *how* to live by faith and *how* to trust in the Atonement of His Son, but we have to first make that *choice!* Hebrews 12:14 “*Persistently strive for peace with all men, and for that growth in holiness apart from which no one will see the Lord.*”

God is waiting for our response, and He wants to teach us what we need to know—about Him, His Son, and the Holy Spirit. God will enable us to meet everything according to His Word—but we have to decide to *let* Him do it.

Teaching people to *live by faith* in Christ, and to *trust in faith* on God for salvation, can be said in different ways, but God’s Truth cannot change and will always continue—because it is *His* Eternal Truth—he is our Avenger, Deliverer, Protector, Supplier, and Healer—if we are *willing* to place our faith in His divine power.

A believing trust on the atoning Blood of Christ, is the true Christian life of faith—it is *God’s Truth* that continues forever and cannot ever change!



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
