

(REALLY MEAN TO A TRULY SURRENDERED CHRISTIAN)

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It does not matter how often we read or hear <u>God's</u> <u>Word</u>, each time that we <u>take time</u> to <u>consider</u> <u>it</u>, we should <u>receive</u> <u>new light</u> and <u>spiritual</u> <u>strength</u> from it. <u>The</u> <u>Truth</u> of <u>God's</u> <u>Word</u> becomes more plain, clearer, and more valuable to us, and brings greater <u>spiritual</u> results.(THY WORD IS TRUTH; THE TRUTH WILL SET YOU FREE!)

When we first start out in the Christian life we do not have that clear understanding of the Truth. When I started in the Christian life many years ago (the late Pastor said), "the Truth of God's Word did not mean one thing to me." What I <u>felt</u> and what I <u>saw meant everything, and the thoughts</u> that Satan put into my mind <u>meant a lot</u>" (until God <u>taught me to reject</u> them). However, "if God can get <u>anyone</u> to hold steady in faith, and they will <u>confess</u> and <u>forsake</u> their <u>sins</u>, <u>surrender</u> their <u>life</u> to God <u>without</u> <u>reservation</u>, and (we emphasize that), that surrender is <u>final</u>,... The Holy Spirit will then take possession of that person's life. He (God) will begin to lead, guide, and teach them until He brings them to have <u>clear</u> <u>understanding</u> of His Word as it is written (and <u>that</u> is <u>most</u> 'valuable').

In reality, it is 'all-important' and '<u>spiritually valuable'</u>, (and absolutely <u>necessary</u>), for each one of us to receive a <u>clear</u> <u>understanding</u> of what God is telling us in His Word about His Son's atoning Blood. Then we must <u>believe it</u>, so that we can live out His Word in our life of trust on His 'Promises', and on the <u>power of His</u> <u>Blood</u> which <u>supports</u> those <u>Promises</u>.

At times we may need to <u>remind</u> ourselves, that in God's <u>New</u> <u>Covenant</u> <u>Plan</u>, He does not ask us to do one thing in our own strength, nor to understand things in His Word with our own intellect. He <u>does</u>, however, <u>tell</u> <u>us</u> to <u>be</u> <u>willing</u> to <u>listen</u> to His Word, and <u>be</u> <u>willing</u> to <u>follow</u> the <u>teaching</u> and guidance of the <u>Holy</u> <u>Spirit</u>. (Luke 9:35) "Then there came a voice from within the cloud: "This is My Son, My Chosen One: listen to Him."

If God can find a person who is <u>willing</u> to listen and <u>do</u> <u>as</u> He <u>asks</u> (<u>trust on Him</u> and <u>hold steady</u> regardless of the circumstances), His Spirit will lead them to understand and believe on His Word as it was written for us to <u>follow</u> <u>by</u> <u>faith</u>. (John 16:13) "But when He has come—the <u>Spirit of Truth—He</u> will <u>guide</u> you into all the truth. For He will not speak as Himself originating what He says, but all that He hears He will speak, and He will make known the future to you." We cannot truly comprehend how spiritually valuable that is in a true Christian life of faith on God's Word (to <u>understand</u> what <u>Jesus'</u> Blood <u>sacrifice</u> should mean to <u>us.</u>

The cause of all our troubles in the Christian life, is not knowing and not doing according to God's Word. "The devil cannot lay a finger on <u>any</u> human being until they become un-Scriptural", (when they <u>take themselves out from under</u> that <u>covering Blood</u> of Jesus Christ) (by <u>their own choice</u> to <u>not obey</u> God's Word). When we go <u>against His Word</u>, we forsake the love and mercy that He extended to us through the atoning sacrifice of His Son in our behalf. (Mark 3:35) "For wherever there is one who has been obedient to God, there is my brother, my sister, and my mother."

Satan cannot harm a person who lives (and walks) according to God's <u>Word</u>, <u>because</u> His <u>Truth</u> <u>is</u> our <u>shield</u> and <u>buckler</u>. (Psalm91:4) "He shall cover you with His feathers, And under His wings you shall take refuge; His Truth shall be your shield and buckler." (Protector)

This is not to infer in any way that a person not in perfect obedience to the Word of God is on their way to the Lake of Fire. When we first come to God, we are ignorant of the full Truth and spiritually blind concerning the real depth and meaning of His Word (and we do not learn it all in a day). After fifty years in the Truth of God, His Word is still becoming clearer and more understand-able than ever before in our Christian life (the late Pastor said). It is not that we did not know anything about it before, but as we hold steadfast and grow in the Truth, God's Word will open up to us faster and more clearly than before, and we will be enabled to see and follow it out as it is written. This, of course, will always be to the glory of God "Who gives that spiritual increase."

God does not condemn us because we do not know everything about His Word when we begin our 'life of trust' on His Word, and on the power of Jesus' Blood. (Matt. 12:20) "A bruised reed He will not break, and a smoldering wick He will not snuff out, till He leads Justice to victory."

However, to <u>start</u> <u>out</u> <u>right</u>, we have to be <u>repentant</u>, and be surrendered into God's hands; pardoned and cleansed, and with the <u>Holy Spirit in control</u> of our <u>life</u>,..then <u>He</u> will do whatever is needed (spiritually in our heart), (because that is <u>the expressed</u> <u>purpose</u> of the Holy Spirit coming into this world) "to lead us into all Truth." That means <u>He</u> will enable us to learn all about what God's Word says and be inspired to <u>believe</u> <u>it</u> and <u>obey</u> <u>it</u>.

We will never enter into our full inheritance in Christ, and never be made ready for Eternal Life, until we <u>allow</u> God to do the spiritual work needed in our life to make us Scriptural in everything. That means a <u>final decision</u> on <u>our part</u> to trust in the 'living God' for everything in our life, however, it <u>will result in</u> perfect <u>happiness</u> and perfect <u>protection</u>, and it will mean that the <u>devil is defeated</u> and will not be able to rob us of our 'atonement rights'. Rather, it will mean everything we could want spiritually, physically, financially, in our home-life (and in every other way),... and, most importantly, it will mean our real preparation for Eternal Life with God's Spirit as our personal Teacher!

It can take many years for us to learn these things and to have clear knowledge of God's Word, and what the Blood of Jesus Christ really means to a <u>true believer</u>, but when we have truly surrendered our life to God and started right in the Christian life, we will then have the promised Holy Spirit to teach us. He is the Master Teacher to do that work in our heart, and <u>He</u> is the <u>only One</u> we should ever look to <u>as our Teacher</u>. We cannot let any man (or Church) <u>get between us and God</u> as our Teacher. God uses men to plant the Word (and to water it), but that is only a small part in proportion to what the Holy Spirit does to <u>remove</u> trust on the <u>selflife</u> from our <u>heart</u>, and to prepare us for Eternal Life (which <u>is</u> something <u>only God</u> can do for us).

The Holy Spirit will use every circumstance in our life, everything that touches us, every time we are attacked by the devil, and every temptation or battle we go through, to prove to us that "all things work together for good to those who love God''. (Rom. 8:28).

We are to be conformed into the very image of Jesus Christ, <u>Who</u> told us (Matt.5:48) "Therefore you shall be perfect, just <u>as</u> your Father in heaven is perfect." (Also, Rom. 12:2 instructs us) "be <u>transformed</u> by the <u>entire renewal</u> of your <u>minds</u>, so that you may learn by experience what God's will is—(that will which is good and beautiful and perfect.")

So, it is vitally important that we have clear understanding of 'WHAT IT MEANS TO BE UNDER THE BLOOD OF JESUS CHRIST', so that we may rely on the power of His Blood to bring us successfully through every trial or test of our faith. In reality, every human being in the entire world is under that Blood. His Blood should be on every door by faith, just as real in God's sight as it was for the Israelites on that Passover Night in Egypt, <u>because</u> Jesus Christ <u>died for the whole world</u> (not just for Israel).

We have all read about what the blood of a sacrificed animal meant to Israel when they obeyed God and placed it over their doors. But Jesus <u>died for the whole world</u>, and He placed God at our side and at our service. To place ourselves in faith under <u>His Blood</u>, <u>means just as much to us today</u> as it ever meant at any time in the Bible. It is a positive fact (which we can prove for ourselves), that when we find out and accept <u>what the Blood means to us</u>, we can <u>claim everything that it means</u> as a present day possession, and it will become a <u>reality in our life</u> because that is what the Bible teaches.

We need to consider what the Blood of Christ <u>means</u> to our <u>spiritual life</u>. Most of us have read that the Blood means perfect health and protection of our bodies (so much so that a dog could not bark to disturb man or animal). Nor could the terrible pestilence enter their homes. <u>That is real protection</u>! (Exod.11:5-7) "and all the firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die, from the first-born of Pharaoh who sits on his throne, <u>even to</u> the firstborn of the female <u>servant</u> who is behind the hand-mill, and all the <u>firstborn</u> of the <u>animals</u>. Then there shall be a great cry throughout all the land of Egypt, such as was not like it before, nor shall be like it again. `But against <u>none of the children of Israel</u> shall a dog move its tongue, against man or beast, that you may know that the Lord does make a difference between the Egyptians and Israel." (That is what it meant to be under the blood of an animal).

We must all realize that everything in a true Christian life has a 'spiritual basis', so that is why we need to consider what the Blood of Christ means to our spiritual life. Divine healing is founded on real spirituality, just as financial victory, and blessing. God's financial plan for a Christian is one of the greatest factors in the 'death of self' (and development of the Christ-life in our heart), as well as development of real faith and real knowledge of God. With each answer to prayer financially, also for healing, deliverance from persecution (or otherwise), we come to a better knowledge of God and His love for us, and of how His Holy Spirit will direct us with our decisions and actions,... if we will follow as He directs us to the right path to follow, or to the correct and Scriptural decision to make on every issue.

To follow <u>God's</u> <u>financial</u> <u>plan</u>, does indeed help to eliminate and remove self-dependance <u>from</u> <u>our</u> <u>heart</u> (which we <u>must</u> <u>allow</u> <u>God</u> to remove), so that we <u>can</u> <u>enter</u> the Kingdom of God <u>`like</u> a child'.

We need to understand that the evil nature of 'self' which we inherited from Adam, is the <u>cause</u> of all the trouble we have ever had in our life. Every ache, pain, or burden; every trouble in our home, or upsetting thing that Satan ever used to disturb our peace, was the <u>result</u> of that evil nature of <u>'self'</u> in <u>our heart</u>. "As long as there is <u>any of</u> that <u>evil nature</u> in us", "there would <u>not</u> be any need for Jesus Christ dying for us. It would not be of any use to try to live the Christ-life" (if we are not willing to <u>allow the Holy</u> <u>Spirit</u> to <u>remove</u> the <u>evil nature of self</u> from <u>our heart</u>). (Mark 10: 15) "In solemn truth I tell you that <u>no one</u> who <u>does not receive</u> the Kingdom of God <u>like</u> a <u>little</u> child will by <u>any</u> possibility enter <u>it</u>.

The Holy Spirit taught Paul what the evil self-nature is all about. The Spirit can <u>teach</u> <u>us</u> <u>the</u> <u>same</u> <u>thing</u>, <u>if</u> we will submit to following His guidance (and not stubbornly go our own way when the Spirit shows us the right thing to do, or a right decision to make). Paul explained (Rom.8:6-7) "For to be <u>carnally minded</u> is <u>death</u>, but to be <u>spiritually</u> minded is <u>life</u> and <u>peace</u>. Because the carnal mind is <u>enmity against</u> <u>God</u>; for it is <u>not</u> <u>subject</u> to the <u>law</u> of <u>God</u>,... nor indeed can be."

God has <u>tried</u> to <u>reveal</u> to <u>us</u> by <u>teaching</u> and <u>example</u> from Genesis to Revelation, <u>that</u> Jesus Christ <u>came</u> to <u>deliver</u> <u>us</u> from that rebellious <u>inward</u> <u>enemy</u>, (that evil nature which we inherited from Adam). Any religion that would approve of one particle of that nature being left in our heart, <u>is a false</u> religion from the <u>devil</u>.

We can be easily tempted to think or say, "Oh it won't matter" (if we just use a little bit of human effort to get what we want in our own way) (or, by some effort of the self-life still in our heart). But that is not what God's Word tells us through Jesus Christ and the apostle Paul (and many others), about what Jesus' Blood has done to take that "sinful nature" out of our heart.

Many of the prophets warned of dire results of trusting on the evil nature of self and the devil. (Jere.17:5-6) "Thus says the Lord: "Cursed is the man who trusts in man And makes flesh his strength, Whose heart departs from the Lord. For he shall be like a shrub in

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the desert, And shall not see when good comes." (vs.7-8) "<u>Blessed</u> is the man who <u>trusts</u> in the <u>Lord</u>, And whose hope is the Lord. For he shall be like a tree planted by the waters, Which spreads out its roots by the river." (vs.9-10) "The heart is <u>deceitful</u> above <u>all</u> <u>things</u>, And desperately wicked; Who can know it? I, the Lord, search the heart, I test the mind, Even to give every man according to his ways, According to the fruit of his doings."

The devil does not care how religious we look or sound, what we profess, or how much <u>outward religion</u> we have), just so that we <u>keep</u> <u>that evil nature</u> in our heart <u>and go into eternity un-prepared</u>. Satan <u>deceived the</u> Catholics to teach that there is a Purgatory (and <u>they claim</u> that a person has another chance to <u>get right with God</u> in Purgatory. He <u>deceived the Presbyterians</u> to say that we <u>sin in</u> <u>thought</u>, word, and <u>deed until we die</u>, and then <u>death</u> is to be our <u>deliverer</u>. <u>Wouldn't that</u> be some <u>poor excuse</u> for a Savior? There is no Scripture to support either of those <u>falsehoods</u> that the devil uses to deceive people, to <u>think that it doesn't matter</u> if the <u>sinful</u> and <u>rebellious</u> self-attitude <u>is still in a person's heart</u>.

It isn't any wonder they have come down to that low level of <u>unbelief</u> and <u>wrong</u> <u>doctrine</u> (and they still go around saying 'I am a <u>believer</u>"), <u>because</u> they <u>never</u> had the <u>Truth</u>, and <u>never</u> <u>knew</u> <u>what</u> <u>'the Truth'</u> is. They never taught <u>what</u> <u>the "Blood of Christ means</u> to a true Christian", <u>nor</u> that God's Word is to be obeyed in everything that we do. <u>They</u> do not think it is <u>necessary</u>, <u>but</u> the Bible says it <u>is necessary</u>. (1 John 2:3-4), "And by this we may know that we know Him- <u>if we obey His commands</u>. He who <u>professes to know Him</u>" (<u>saying they are a believer</u>), "and yet does <u>not obey</u> His <u>commands</u>, is a <u>liar</u>, and the <u>truth</u> has <u>no place</u> in his (or her) <u>heart</u>."

A true <u>believer</u> should <u>keep</u> <u>separate</u> from those who <u>only</u> <u>profess</u> to <u>believe</u>, but who are trusting on <u>plans</u> devised by men, inspired by self, Satan, and from unbelief, and, who engage in worldly activities which feed the evil nature <u>still</u> <u>in</u> their <u>hearts</u>. (2 Cor.6:17 instructs believers), "'Come out from among them and separate yourselves,' says the <u>Lord</u>,". (The Lord cannot say it much plainer than that).

Most <u>denominational</u> church members whom you would <u>ask</u>, "do <u>you</u> <u>think</u> <u>anybody will get to Heaven</u> who <u>does not obey</u> the <u>Word of</u> <u>God?",...</u> they could <u>not</u> (honestly nor correctly) <u>answer</u> your question to save their lives, (much less obey it themselves). They were never taught and do not <u>understand</u> that <u>Jesus came to deliver</u> <u>us from</u> that <u>evil nature</u>.. (so how could we hold onto it?) (Rom.6:6), "This we know—that our old self was nailed to the cross with Him, in order that <u>our sinful nature might be deprived of its power</u>, so that we should no longer be the slaves of sin."

So, we can see that God <u>never</u> asks us to try to live the Christian life <u>(nor</u> to obey His Word) with the evil nature still in our heart. We <u>must trust on God to remove it</u>, so the <u>nature of Jesus</u> <u>Christ can replace it</u>,... and, then <u>believe</u> that <u>Jesus delivered</u> us <u>from</u> that nature. (Rom.6:11) "you also must regard yourselves as dead in relation to sin, but as alive in relation to God, <u>because</u> you are in Christ Jesus." S325R WHAT SHOULD JESUS'BLOOD REALLY MEAN TO SURRENDERD CHRISTIAN 6

To surrender our life to God, and to <u>allow Him</u> to <u>remove</u> that sinful nature from our heart, is something that must take place in our life, <u>because that is</u> the <u>only way we can be prepared by God</u> to receive the <u>Salvation</u> that <u>He offers to us</u>. The <u>Holy Spirit does</u> <u>not dwell in a person's heart</u> (along with <u>self</u> or <u>Satan</u>). <u>Rather</u>, He comes into a <u>clean heart</u>, and we can have that <u>Spirit just for the</u> <u>asking</u>. The Holy Spirit will <u>take possession</u> of any <u>surrendered</u> heart, and <u>then we are in a position</u> to <u>obey God's Word</u>(and to live according to His will). Step by step God will lead us <u>out of</u> every <u>un-Scriptural thing</u> and lead us <u>into</u> every <u>Scriptural thing</u> that is written in God's Word. 'That' is real Christianity!

It is one of <u>many things</u> Jesus' <u>cleansing Blood should mean</u> to every Christian. Jesus Blood is the <u>only merit</u> we have to rely on, to have <u>self</u>, removed;.., <u>and</u> the power of God is the <u>means</u> by which we fulfill God's <u>command</u>, for us to believe and <u>obey</u> and <u>be saved</u> "<u>through faith</u>", <u>by</u> "His <u>grace alone</u>". (Rom.4:16), "All depends on faith, and for this reason—that acceptance with God might be an act of <u>pure grace</u>."

S82R "WHAT JESUS BLOOD REALLY MEANS TO A CHRISTIAN" SOME MAIN POINTS:

1... Nothing could be more important to a Christian than to fully comprehend what the Atonement Blood sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the Cross (has accomplished for them).

2... It is all-important, spiritually valuable, and <u>absolutely</u> <u>necessary</u> for us to read and listen to God's Word, to receive a clear understanding of what God is telling us about His Son's atoning Blood.

3... When we <u>believe</u> what His Word tells us, a 'believer' will then receive the <u>gift</u> of <u>God's</u> <u>Holy</u> <u>Spirit</u>, which <u>is</u> <u>what</u> <u>enables</u> <u>them</u> to live out His Word by trusting on His 'Promises',..<u>because</u> God doesn't <u>ask nor expect</u> <u>us</u> to do that in our own strength, nor even to <u>understand</u> it <u>by our own intellect</u>. <u>That</u> is <u>what</u> <u>the</u> <u>Holy</u> <u>Spirit</u> <u>does</u> for a true 'believer'.

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
