## God's Object of Jesus' Coming to Earth

(To <u>Bring Real Truth of God</u> & His <u>Salvation Plan</u>)

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We need to consider and get to know the Truth of God so clearly and plainly that we will all see it as it really is, and as God meant for it to be understood and known by all of mankind. It is the only Truth that will make our lives what they should be and must be because it is the only Truth that will prepare us for Eternal Life!

Every religious organization (including the Catholic church and the Protestant churches), and all other kind of missionaries, have never discovered this 'Truth of God' (the late Pastor remarked), and they have never been in an attitude of mind and heart to God, by which He could reveal it to them. God is the only One to reveal any Truth.

If a person will put their life into God's hands <u>in</u> repentance and faith, however, (and then hold steady in faith), He has promised to guide then into all Truth (John 16:13). And <u>God</u> <u>is</u> the <u>only One</u> who can do that for us.

When we first come to God, we are just opposite to what we should be in our attitude toward His Word. His Word does not mean a thing to us, and we are absolutely still buried under centuries of misleading and false teaching that is under the devil's influence and control.

That all has to be changed, it has to be remedied and corrected, since we all have to grow spiritually, step by step and day by day under God's teaching and His control, until we really and truly get down to understanding and knowing the Word of God in itself. That will take a great deal of teaching through trial and temptations, and a long period of workmanship and training by the Holy Spirit of God'.

But it is well-worth it for us to get back to the Word of God in our life, home, and family, that is, to where we see His Word as it is and follow it as it should and must be followed. So, we must get the right attitude of submissiveness in our heart that we should be taken toward God's

Word. Then it is, of course that, along with that right attitude that we will be enabled to see and understand the full Truth that we are considering today.

John the Baptist said truthfully (and as the Bible teaches repeatedly), that "a man cannot receive anything <u>unless it be given</u> him <u>from above</u>." It is valuable for all of us to know that, and it will answer the question of why most churches of the world and the average professing Christians do not get any real spiritual light from above. In most instances, God's Word does not mean a thing to them, as they pay <u>no attention to it</u>, <u>nor know it</u>, <u>believe it</u>, <u>nor obey it</u>.

The reason is, they have never been in a position where they would let God, or allow Him to teach them anything, or to give them anything 'from above'. They have been taught by man, carnally-minded man, unbelievers who (in many cases) do not trust on God themselves, and we know from many verses of Scripture that unbelievers do not receive the blessing of God's Holy Spirit to guide them in the Truth of God. (John 14:17) "That Spirit the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him or know Him. You know Him because He remains by your side and is in you." (But John 1:12 re-assures those who do trust on God) "But all who have received Him, to them—that is, to those who trust in His name, — He has given the privilege of becoming children (To allow oneself to be taught by of God." carnally-minded men who are not trusting on God for things in their life, but instead, are depending on the insurance of man's many financial plans of trust), is like (the late Pastor said), "the blind leading the blind, and both falling into the ditch together"(as Jesus Christ said for us to know).

"It was the same in the time when Jesus was here on earth. His disciples were a long time getting rid of the idea that the Jewish churches were doing some good. They could not believe that with a pious 'outward front' the Pharisees and Sadducees put up, that they were not one bit of good whatever to help people get into the faith, (since they were under the power of the devil). Jesus had a difficult time convincing his disciples that those false teachers were no good influence and would never be any good (without them making a true repentance and turn-around as Saul later made).

It was when Jesus said something like that, that the disciples answered, "do you know that the Scribes and the Pharisees were greatly offended at what you said?" (They meant that, what He had

said would be a hindrance to them accepting the Truth, and 'getting in a right position to accept your teaching'.) (They didn't know nor understand that they were no good, and that even a thought would be wasted on them. Jesus answered the disciples clearly in pointed language, saying, "let them alone, they are blind leaders of the blind, and they will both fall into the ditch together."

Jesus also said, "every tree that my Father has not planted will be rooted up," and that is still true today. Eventually, the disciples were convinced that the Scribes and Pharisees (and the so-called Christians of His day), were wholly bad, and wholly controlled by the devil, and that it was not a particle of use to spend any time on them. Whatever time or thought spent on them would be wasted. That is, of course the same today, and it is the same in any Age.

The Truth that we want to consider in all of this, is that Jesus Christ came to deliver us out of the troubles of this present life. we are to get our deliverance in God's way by His power, and according to His Word, and that is the real Gospel. It is also the only plan or way we will ever receive perfect happiness in this life. The most serious thing of all-- it is the only way we will ever get Eternal Life.

The average churches, and average professing Christians, do not know anything about getting our deliverance in God's way by His power, and according to His Word. Most all have separated the things of this life from the Gospel, or the devil has made them separate it. They trust in man for things needed or wanted in their life here, or trust in themselves or someone else, while they fondly and vainly think that they are trusting on God for eternal life. ('Watch out that ye be not deceived', Jesus warned us, since Satan is out to deceive and devour us, and take us to the Lake of Fire.)

There is not a particle of Eternal Life (not even one inch of pathway to take us toward it the Pastor said), outside of our trusting on God for things in this life, which is something that the average person is entirely unaware and ignorant of. Most of them claim that they can be spiritually ok without trusting on God, and that they will still go to Heaven without trusting Him for things in this life, such as their healing, their financial needs, peace in their home life, and with everything else that concerns them.

We need to consider and have explained to us from Scriptures, which gives three-fold proof that, that personal trust on God is what the Gospel consists of, and it was the whole primary object of Jesus' coming to earth. For one to be shown that, is to have a thoroughly Scriptural foundation for our belief and our faith on an unseen God and on the One whom He has sent. 'If you have seen Me' Jesus told us (and of course He was talking about future followers spiritually seeing Him), 'you have seen the Father', (and nothing could be more important than that).

In truth, there is no greater sin that a person can commit than to turn his back on God for things in this life, and then to trust in himself or some other human plan or power to get what he wants in this life. That is the dividing line between true and false Christians. Real Christians as we read of in Bible times, trusted on God for things in their life. False Christians did not do so, but instead, they separated the Truth of God, and it is the same way today.

True Christians are hunting for ways to trust God for everything that pertains to their life. False Christians are those under the control of the devil, who trust in themselves and depend on the many plans of man (for their provisions and to be insured of financial security, instead of full trust on God's power and Promises to provide and protect His people). That is the great dividing line, and we could never too thoroughly understand that, because it is the real Truth and our only hope for our life here and our only hope of ever escaping the Lake of Fire after our life here on earth.

One can easily notice and see all around themselves, that there are two things about false religions and those under who are under the teaching of the devil without them knowing it. In the first place, they do not trust God for the things of this life, nor do they deal with God personally about anything else in their life. (Instead, they will always turn to one of the plans of man to get what they want or need, with buying on credit or on time payment plans and go into debt against Scripture, and then worry about paying for it later, or by relying on one of the many insurance plans devised by Satan and implemented by fallen man to protect them financially.) Consequently, and in reality, they become separated from God just as much as Adam was separated after he fell to Satan's deceitful plan in his day.

That is the sin that caused all of this trust in man and his many plans of the self-life (all of this trust in ourselves or some other human plan or power for things in this life). That is the cause of all other sins, therefore, it is the greatest of all sins, self-life trust is not gotten rid of because if that and taken out of one's heart, they cannot enter the Kingdom of Heaven. That is why it is the greatest of all sins, and the cause of all the trouble that has ever been in the world (as has often been said before). It is the cause of all that Satan has ever done, and the seat of his control over a person, and the manifestation of those two secret hidden enemies that can live within us, and they are 'self' and 'the devil'. While they are still in control, no human being could trust in God for anything.

Therefore, it is a fact that God has to deliver us from them (those two hidden enemies), and then we will have a clean heart to trust on Him. Then we will be in a position where we will be enabled to trust on God for everything, until we are fully victorious in a life of faith in our life here on earth.

We should further consider about this question and topic of human trust, that it was that one very sin that Adam committed (eating the forbidden fruit against God's command not to eat it), that gave Satan possession of him and filled him with the obsession that he could be his own god, and get what he would like to have in this life (including happiness), but get it without the slightest help from God (in Whom we are to trust to enable us to get all things in our life).

That trust in 'self' is not even considered sin anymore, while most people consider it to be wise, sensible, and good judgement of a person (to get things in their own way instead of in the 'will of God'. But, if we (each one of us) would go back to trusting on God instead of on man, they would count us to be of an unsound mind and just acting crazy. But what it really shows is just how deep the darkness really is within them, and Jesus said, "if the light in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness!"

They have not the least idea that the real Truth of God truly consists of trusting Him for things in this life, instead of on themselves or some other plan or person. They think that it is just ridiculous for us to trust on God, by our taking His Word seriously and doing what it says, by trusting on Him.

It is important for us to realize and know the cause of those attitudes that they hold. It is because the only teaching they have received (as far as religion goes the late Pastor said), is from the devil and his agents. And that should be a warning to each one of us to keep as far away from such an attitude as that, as God enables us to stay away from them.

The Old Testament prophecies about what Jesus was coming to do for people in this world, and why He was coming to die for us, had to do with this 'present life'. That is very significant, and it is all-convincing. When God told us through the prophets what Jesus was coming to do for us, well, that was real and that was true, and that was the Word of God!

Also, when He put in those prophesies, only the things that relate to this present life, .. that means He was coming to deliver us from the things of this present life, first of all, .. while He well-knew that Eternal Life would later follow us, and our getting delivered from the sorrows and troubles of this present life.

We can consider the all-embracing promise that Jesus gave us in Mark 11, when He was going from Jerusalem to Bethany where He stayed the night, and on His return to Jerusalem He saw a fig tree along the road without any fruit on it. He said to the fig tree, "let no one ever again eat fruit from thee!"

Early the next morning as they passed by the tree again, the disciples were amazed to see that that fig tree had withered away, and they marveled about that happening to that fig tree, ... and saying, "how soon is the fig tree withered away!"

Jesus answered them saying (Mark 11:23-24), "Have faith in God! In solemn truth I tell you that if any one shall say to this mountain, 'Remove, and hurl thyself into the sea,' and has no doubt about it in his heart, but steadfastly believes that what he says will happen, it shall be granted him. That is why I tell you, as to whatever you pray and make request for, if you believe that you have received it, it shall be yours."

That puts the entire power of God at our service, and that means for this (our) present life. And God is with us and for us, while He verifies what Jesus said and told us before He went away, "All power and authority has been give Me in Heaven and on earth. And, Lo, I am with you

always even to the end of the world." (meaning, end of 'the Gospel Age').

"I am with you always", relates to this present life of ours, our spiritual life here, our bodies, our home, and everything else that concerns us financially and with other things.

Then Jesus followed up with, saying, "that's why I tell you that, whatever things soever you desire" (meaning, <u>whatever things</u> you would like to have <u>within God's will</u>). That doesn't mean to go to Heaven when you die, but it means 'what you would like to have in this present life.

We may question, what are people seeking after by their own efforts? They seek after righteousness, the seek after peace, they seek after good health, and seek after everything else, especially so seek after money (the big dollar that many are seeking with a vengeance, the late Pastor said), (and how true that still is today as we can see that among people all around us in this world, while not realizing that their place of trust is not being placed on God where it should be placed, but <u>rather</u>, being placed on a self-life of man).

Why do they do that? It is because they think that will make them happy, and that is why they want it. However, what God's Word teaches us is to trust God for "what things soever ye desire when ye pray", which means to seek it from God for this life and so, have and enjoy His perfect happiness in our life here on earth.

When God's Word says, "what things soever ye desire when ye pray, believe that ye have received them, and ye shall have them." That promise fully relates to this present life, what we desire to have here spiritually, physically, in our home life, and financially with all that God wants us to have. We are to seek things from God, trust on Him alone for them, and believe to receive them.

Therefore, all the Promises of God are meant for us in this life, and everyone of them are related to this present life here. Also, each Promise teaches us and sends us to God alone, for their fulfillment in our life here.

So, in summary, the <u>real Truth</u>, the <u>real</u> Gospel, and everything that will deliver us out or our troubles in this life (and <u>prepare us for 'eternal life' with God</u>, <u>is</u> to be <u>trusting</u> on God instead of man for things in this life, and so, be prepared by God for eternity. Best of all and most important of

all, is that it will be the Truth that will save us from the Lake of Fire and will enable us to spend an eternity with God, in Heaven. And we all need to realize that eternity means <u>forever</u> after this life on earth, so we want to be sure that it is spent in Heaven (<u>not spent in that</u> only other place, that Lake of Fire with Satan forever!!)

- 1. God's <u>objective</u> for <u>sending His Son to this earth</u> is a vital principle of Truth, and something that every person should consider and clearly understand, and to also realize that it is the only Truth that will (or can) prepare us for Eternal Life.
- 2. When we are given a clear understanding of that Truth, we will (by God's grace) be enabled to realize that the attitudes of the self-life that we are all born with, are just opposite to what our attitude should be.
- 3. Most every religious organization in the world have never discovered that 'Truth of God', since in many cases their attitude in mind and heart is not receptive for God teach that to them. That all must be remedied, changed, and corrected, since that needs to take place in our heart and mind so we can grow spiritually in God's Truth.

However, if a person will (in repentance and faith) put their life into God's hands, He has promised us that He will guide us into all Truth,

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
