

God's Full Truth Doctrine For Our Salvation

(Corrupted By Satan with
Apathetic Followers)

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God's **full Truth** from His **unchangeable Word** is not exclusive to any one church or to any person or group, but, rather, it is available for all people of any time, or from any location on earth. However, a person needs to read or hear the Truth of God's Word and believe it; by God's grace understand it; accept it; and live it in faith every day by the power of the Holy Spirit. (2 Tim.3:16-17) *"All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the 'man of God' may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works."* How a person 'walks in light of God's Truth' is embedded within and clearly explained in 'God's Word'.

The apostle warned (2 Tim.4:3-4) *"For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they 'heap to themselves teachers', having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables."*

Satan's object has always been to corrupt the Truth of God's Word by mixing in delusions as are followed by many people of the world. The devil does that with a purpose to destroy souls, all of whom are precious in God's sight. (Rom.1:18) *"For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven, against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness."* Those unbelievers, the apostle said (Rom.1:25) *"changed the truth of God into a lie."* (Again, God's 'doctrine of full Truth' is in the Bible for anyone to read; believe; and live it out every day.)

The devil has succeeded for many centuries to corrupt the Word of God, and thus, hindering people from receiving the many wonderful and marvelous benefits of the provisions of God, through the atoning sacrifice

of His Son. Satan always fought against vital truths of Bible doctrine.

First, the shedding of Christ's Blood as the only sacrifice and merit required for Believers; Secondly, the power of the Holy Spirit as the only means and way for one's deliverance; and Third, the 'Word of God' as the only plan or doctrine for all to receive what God wants to give us.

Numerous religions of many different names have been used by Satan to delude people on these *three vital truths*. The 'erroneous doctrine' of 'Christian Science' has been used by the devil to deceive its followers. They reject the atoning *Blood* of Christ; and the human *mind* substitutes or takes the place of God's power, and the *writings of their founder* are followed, instead of God's 'written Word' being followed.

From the beginning Satan has succeeded in corrupting the teaching of God's Word in the minds of most people, concerning present day and future results of unrepentant sin. He deceived Adam and Eve when he told them they would not die, but they proved that to be a lie.

The devil continues to deceive many people by having them think that there will be no evil results in this life, nor will there be any eternal punishment for unrepentant sin. That type of doctrine makes many people apathetic and indifferent to God's 'doctrine of Truth'. That results in their being unprepared for eternal life, but ready for eternal death in the Lake of Fire.

In the first Garden, as long as Adam had believed and obeyed God's Word, he was to enjoy God's peace, health, and protection. When mankind put aside God's *Word*, and they accepted Satan's lie, everything changed, sin came into the world, and they were controlled by the devil.

God's only begotten Son; the shedding of His precious Blood on Calvary's Cross; and His death and resurrection to life, is the all-sufficient sacrifice, merit, and only payment that God requires for a full restoration of that relationship we lost, through Adam's first sin.

In Jesus, God has restored for us a second Adam, along with all the righteousness, peace, health, healing, protection, and victory over Satan's power, that had been lost through the sin of the first Adam. (Hebr.9:14) *"How much more shall the blood of Christ, Who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?"*

The full Truth Doctrine given in the Bible, clearly teaches us that it is the divine power of God that delivers us from the power of sin and Satan. We are to be filled with His divine power, which will lead a person to victory over Satan's power. (Rom.6:4) *"Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life."*

The power of God alone, is what our dependence must be on, for the health, healing, and protection of our body. Every human plan, home remedy and therapy, or device for healing, must be set aside forever. (We are not to depend on or allow other things or man's plans, to become a hindrance to receiving healing from God, and our victory through the healing power of Jesus' Atonement Blood that He shed to provide healing). (Isaiah 53:4) *"But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him, and with his stripes we are healed."*

The 'power of God' is to control our homes (not our efforts of a self-life in our heart) and give our loved ones a desire to live the Truth of the Bible, also to prepare us for the return of Christ. (1 John 1:7) *"If we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin."*

The 'Word of God' is the only plan by which we are to receive the 'benefits of Atonement', and the outstanding inheritance that Atonement provides for each one of us. The 'Word of God' gives us directions concerning everything—and as long as we follow these instructions, we will be delivered from problems and troubles and will be in a position to receive God's blessings in all things.

The Word contains amazing promises by which we can partake of the very nature of God, and all other things that we need and desire for this life—as well as receiving the promise of eternal life. (2 Peter 1:3-4) *"According as His divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust."*

God's Word plainly teaches that people who neglect His great Salvation plan, and who die in their sins, will go to the lake of fire to be tormented forever. The Word says (Rev.21:8) *"The fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death."*

Very few people in the so-called 'Christian Church' today, actually believe this Bible teaching on 'eternal torment'. They say that a God of love would never consign people to such a fate. They lose sight of the fact that we are born free moral agents, and that we all have the power of choice (to decide our own fate),(whether a believer or an unbeliever).

Jesus said to us (John 5:24) *"Verily, verily I say unto you, He that heareth my Word, and believeth on Him that sent me, hath 'everlasting life', and shall not come into condemnation: but is passed from death unto life."* (That is quite a Promise from God's Son, for each one who will make their choice to hear and believe to follow Him (the Son of God's directions and example set for us to follow Him, Who told us to *"Come follow Me"*).

God does not consign anyone to the lake of fire, but our fate is in our own hands, and if we refuse to avail ourselves of 'God's way of escape from the 'flames of eternal torment'', but the responsibility of such a fate is entirely on us to use our power of choice' and correctly decide. If we refuse to walk in the light of God's Truth; if we reject His offer of mercy and grace, then sorrow, suffering, sickness, and trouble is the inevitable result. It is what we sow, we shall also reap.

These vital truths, 'the Blood of Christ'; the 'Power of God'; and 'the Word', being the merit, means, and plan, are all part of God's 'Full Truth Doctrine'. Satan uses many delusions and false doctrines to corrupt the 'Word of God', so there are many 'professing Christians' who do not know, or do not follow the 'plan of God'.

There are a large number of false religions today. Seventh Day Adventists; Muslims; Buddhists; Hindus; Taoists; Mormonism; Judaism; Scientology (and many more with various other names). With all of them, one or more of those vital truths are omitted, rejected, or simply ignored, ...the merit of the Blood of Christ;

the means through the power of the Spirit; and the plan of following the 'Word of Truth'.

The only one way that we can be kept from (escape) being led astray by Satan, when he approaches us as an 'angel of light', is to completely surrender our life to do God's will, to receive the fullness of His Holy Spirit within our heart (and Whom Jesus told us that He, that Spirit) "will guide you into all Truth". (That would be preparing us for Eternity)!

(1 John 2:26-27) *"These things I have written to you concerning those who try to deceive you. But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him."*

There are many, many people who are led astray, and who eventually perish, ..so the apostle explained why. (2 Thess. 2:10-12) *"Because they received not 'the love of the truth', 'that they might be saved'. And for this cause God shall send them 'strong delusion', that they should believe a lie: That they all might be damned who believed not the Truth, but had 'pleasure in unrighteousness'."*

We can be certain that no sincere and honest soul will ever be led astray spiritually who is willing to follow God's instructions (from His Word), and willing to do His will in all circumstances of life. .

We often go through trials, meet temptations, and may even be temporarily hindered in making spiritual progress, but God promises, and He will (Psalm 91:3) says *"deliver thee from the snare of the fowler,"* (or, *"rescue you from every trap and protect you."*)

The Lord's 'Full Truth Doctrine' will teach us, and will emphasize to us, the importance of full obedience to the 'Word of God', especially the New Testament, (and the Old Testament where it supports the teaching of the New Testament. It is the only way for us to be prepared by God for entering His Eternal Kingdom.

Jesus told everyone (Matt.7:21) *"Not every one who says to me, 'Master, Master,' will enter the Kingdom of the Heavens, but only those who are obedient to [who are doing the will of] my Father who is in Heaven."*

(1 John 2:4-6) *"He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and*

the truth is not in him. But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him. He that saith he abideth in him, ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked."

Jesus explained that true faith and believing trust on Him for everything in this life, is something only the Holy Spirit could inspire in our heart to do. (Luke 17:21) *"The Kingdom of God is within you,"* He said. Jesus went on to explain, that a childlike faith and trust on God, is required for entering His kingdom (Mark 10:14) *"for of such [faith] is the kingdom of God."*

The one requirement for eternal life, is being willing to put our faith and trust on the Atonement Blood of Jesus Christ. (John 3:18) *"He who is believing in Him is not judged, but he who is not believing hath been judged already, ..because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God."*

The 'Full Truth Doctrine' is given for us in the Bible. (1 John 5:13) *"These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."* Are we fully depending on the "Full Truth Doctrine" that God has given us to believe and trust in, or are we allowing ourselves to place part of our trust in something—or someone—else, perhaps thinking it does not matter? God's Word tells us that it does matter as we strive to enter the narrow gate into His heavenly Kingdom, just as Jesus instructed us to do in Luke 13:24.



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
